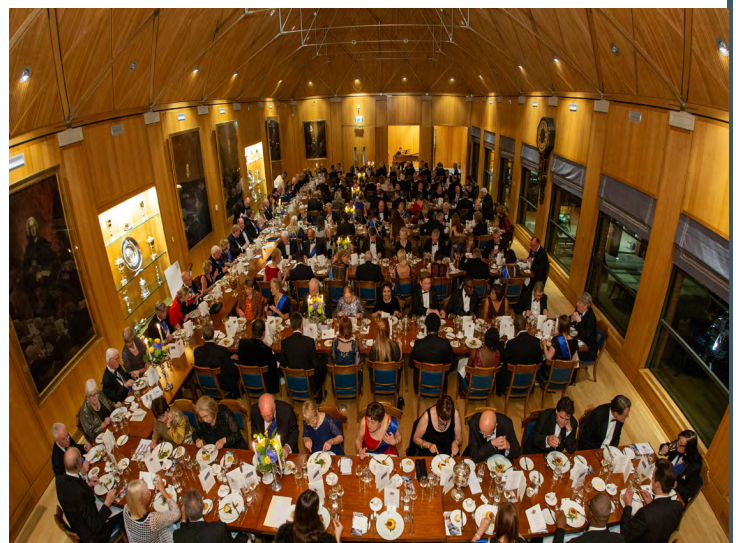
Speaker
