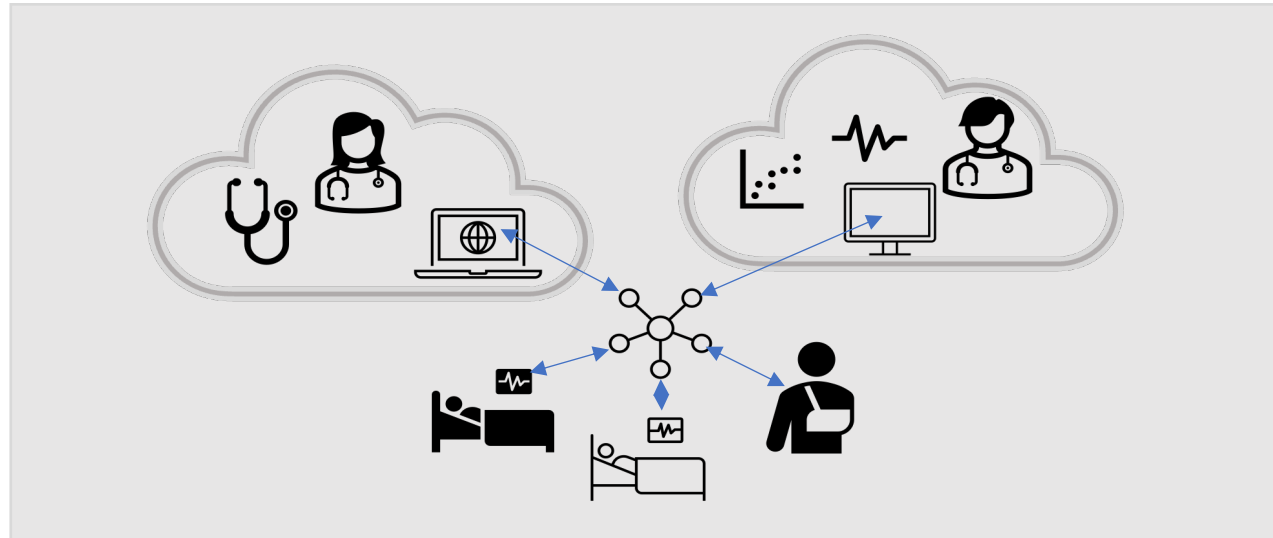


# WCIT Medicine & Health Panel Event
